



b) Special Specifications

The special specifications are an amplification of the Standard Specifications for Construction and maintenance of Roads and Bridges, Second Edition June 2009, published by the Institute of Construction Training and Development (ICTAD) and contain provisions in respect of items of work not covered by or at variance with the Standard Specifications.

Where there is any ambiguity or discrepancy between the special specifications and the Standard Specifications, the requirements of Special specifications prevail.

b) Special Specification

Series 100 – General

117 SETTING OUT, CROSS SECTIONS, SURVEY AND DRAWINGS

Deleted clause 117 and substitute with following

SURVEY, DESIGN AND DRAWINGS

General

The drawings issued by the employer at the bidding stage are conceptual design drawings which comprise only typical and outline construction details and have not been based on detailed topographical surveys. The contractor shall be responsible for conducting all topographical and other necessary surveys and design activities to establish and execute the final design of the project as required under the contract.

The contractor is responsible for the geometrical design after carrying out surveying and leveling.

The contractor shall employ on the works a qualified surveyor. The surveyor shall be fully equipped with modern survey equipment and instruments, which must be approved by the Engineer. Competent chainmen shall be employed to assist the surveyor.

The contractor shall deploy sufficient and qualified survey, design and drafting staff to enable the survey results and the subsequent design process to be completed and the Engineer's approval to be obtained as described hereunder, in advance of the construction activities as indicated on his program. Drafting staff shall include computer operators experienced in using Auto CAD.

The contractor shall assist and provide services of the surveyor and his team to the engineer whenever required by the engineer or his representatives in checking and measuring the works.

Bench marks and reference monuments.

The contractor shall establish and fully reference all survey control points, monuments and working bench marks soon after taking possession of the site on structures such as bridges and culverts. The contractor shall be solely responsible for safeguarding all survey monuments, benchmarks, beacons, etc.

Survey data pertaining to these control points/ bench marks shall be submitted to the engineer for verification. Checks shall be made on these benchmarks once every month and adjustments, if any, shall be agreed with the engineer and record. An up-to-date record of all benchmarks including approved adjustment, if any shall be maintained by the contractor and also a copy applied to the engineer for his record. A "survey file" containing the necessary data shall be made available by the contractor for this purpose.

The contractor shall complete initial site clearing works as instructed by the Engineer Before starting any survey works.

The contractor shall carry out a survey of the existing road and produce the required information as indicated in following paragraphs.

• Timing

Within two (2) weeks following receipt of the letter of acceptance, the contractor shall commence survey works to establish the vertical and horizontal profiles of the existing road, details of the existing drainage and structures, boundaries and topographical features within the road corridor. The survey drawings recording all such existing features and alignment shall be prepared and submitted to the Engineer in tranches of 0.5 km (maximum), or other length acceptable to the Engineer, for his review and acceptance. The first survey drawing will be returned by the Engineer to the contractor within 10 days of receipt marked as either 'Accepted' or 'For Correction' as appropriate. Survey drawings submitted thereafter will be returned appropriately marked within 10 days of the return of the previous drawing.

• Centre-line

The existing center-line must be accurately surveyed and referenced and a schedule of reference dimensions shall be prepared and supplied by the Contractor to the Engineer.

No reference peg or marker shall be moved or withdrawn without the approval of the engineer and earthworks, concrete or structural work shall commence until the center line has been referenced and approved by the Engineer.

Centre-line reference marks shall be maintained until the works reach finished formation level and are accepted by the Engineer. On reaching formation level stage, the center-line shall again be set out by the contractor and when approved by the engineer, shall be accurately referenced to marked pegs set at the outer limits of the formation in a manner satisfactory to the Engineer.

Cross-Section

The contractor shall, after or in connection with, the staking out of the center-line, survey the terrain along the existing road center-line and cross-section at 10 meter intervals for road sections.

The cross sections shall extent 2 meters beyond the exiting right-of-way on either side. The vertical and horizontal scales of the cross section drawing shall be 1:20 and 1:50 respectively or as otherwise instructed by the Engineer. The vertical and horizontal scales of the longitudinal profile drawing shall be 1:200 and 1:1000 respectively or as otherwise instructed by the Engineer.

117.2 Measurement

The quantity to be measured for setting out center line of carriageway including detail survey of the roadway shall be at the unit rate per km. of road stretch surveyed.

The quantity to be measured for cross sections shall be the number of cross sections detailed on Construction Drawings, produced and approved by the Engineer. No separate measurement shall be made for benchmarks, surveying of culverts. Retaining structures, bridges etc, and other survey works carried for execution of the work.

117.3 Payment

The initial setting out and detail survey works measured shall be paid for at the unit rate per km. The prices shall be full compensation for all labour, materials, survey equipment, and incidentals required. The prices for designed cross sections produced in construction drawings shall be full compensation of all labour, materials, drafting material and equipment, and the services of the Design Engineer and support staff as required.

The setting out of works and other survey works required for the execution of Works shall not be paid separately and are deemed to be included in the contractor's overhead cost.

120.1 Supervision of work - Wages of Technical officer (all-inclusive)

120.1.1 General

One technical officer qualified with NVQ 5 or equivalent should be assigned in a full-time basis. Prior approval for the technical officer should be taken from the Engineer.

120.1.2 Payments

All costs shall be included in the bidder's overhead and profits or bidding rates.

120.2 Supervision of work - Wages of Supervisor (all-inclusive)

120.2.1 General

One full-time supervisor should be assigned who is qualified NVQ 4 or equivalent. The engineer should give prior approval for the supervisor.

120.2.2 Payments

All costs shall be included in the bidder's overhead and profits or bidding rates.

120.3 Accommodation for Labors

120.3.1 General

The accommodation building should be closer to the site. The minimum area is 1200ft^2 (approximately 111m^2) with electricity, water facility, and other sanitary facilities, etc.

506.6 Measurement and Payment

(a) Measurement

Asphalt concrete surfacing shall be measured by the following methods: -

(i) For uniform Thickness

Delete the text under this item and substitute.

Asphalt concrete surfacing shall be measured by sq.m of mix furnished, spread, compacted, completed, and accepted. Measurements shall be of the areas and thickness as shown on the drawings, described in the specification, or instructed by the Engineer.

Deficiencies in the thickness of the wearing course shall unless an overlay is constructed at the contractor's expense, result in a proportion only of the wearing course area being measured for payment. Proportions shall be determined by the thickness deficiencies and area proportions described below

The thickness of the asphalt concrete wearing course shall be determined by average caliper measurement of cores, rounded upwards to the nearest mm.

Paved sections to be measured separately shall consist of each 100 lin. m section in each traffic lane. The last section in each traffic lane shall be 100 m plus the fractional part of 100 m remaining. At areas such as intersections, entranced, crossovers, ramps etc. It shall be measured at one section and the thickness of each shall be determined separately. Small irregular unit areas may be included as part of another section.

One core shall be taken from each section by the contractor at approved locations and in the presence of the Engineer. When the measurement of the core from any paved section is not deficient by more than 5mm from the specified thickness, the core will be deemed to be of the specified thickness as shown on the drawing.

When the measurement of the core from any paved section is deficient by more than 5 mm but not more than 15 mm, 2 additional cores spaced at not less than 25 m and as decided by the Engineer shall be taken and used together with the first core to determine the average thickness of such section.

When the measurement of the core from any paved section is less than the specified thickness by more than 15 mm, the average thickness of such section shall be determined by taking additional cores at not less than 5 m intervals parallel to the centerline in each direction from the affected location until, in each direction, a core is taken which is not deficient by more than 20 mm. Exploratory core deficient thickness will not be used in average thickness determinations.

Any deficiencies in the total thickness of wearing courses shall be subject to a proportional reduction in the area of wearing course measured for paying. Alternatively, the contractor shall construct all at his own expense, a wearing course overlay, if practicable in the judgment of the Engineer. Any such overlay shall be a minimum of 50 mm compacted thicknesses and to the specified standard of the course it is overlaying.

All the core holes cut for the testing should be properly filled with asphalt cold mix immediately (or any other equivalent material accepted by the Engineer) as it need to seal water infiltration to the base. So until the core holes properly filled by the contractor, 70% of value of the asphalt payment only paid.


